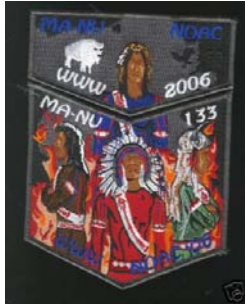
We had outstanding support from arrowmen serving as Elangomats. We had 22 members serve in this vital position. Thank you to all who helped without your service this event would not have been as successful.

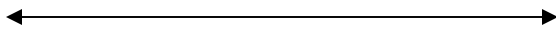

Approximate cost per Arrowman is \$600. Registration is being limited to 30-50, so if you are interested in attending this national event you need to get your registration in as soon as possible.

2010 Council contingent signup for the National Jamboree has begun. The Jamboree will run from July 26-August 4, 2010. You must be a registered Boy Scout or Varsity Scout and have attained the rank of First Class by the 2010 jamboree. Also you must have completed the 6<sup>th</sup> grade or be at least 12 years old by July 1, 2010 but not yet 18 by August 4, 2010. Signing up **does not guarantee** you a slot on the contingent. The council contingent committee will review all applications for approval. Approximate cost to attend is \$3,000. A \$100 deposit is required at time of signup plus \$10 for application fee.
